

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO FILMING POLICY

Within Auditoria (Clyde, Lomond, Hall 2)

NO flash photography is permitted when the auditorium lights are down. Individuals are asked to respect the presenters' during this time.

Photographs may be taken during panel discussion sessions, providing they are not obtrusive.

During any case presentations sessions again there should be absolutely no flash photography at any time when the lights are down.

Exhibition Hall/Poster Areas

Anyone wishing to take photographs may do so. Individuals are asked to respect that some people may not wish to be photographed.

Congress Centre Public Areas

As the SECC is a public building there may be members of the general public within the building at any time. These individuals may wish not to be photographed; please respect their privacy.

Press Conference

Normal lighting will be in place throughout this session. Individuals may photograph members of the panel with their permission.

Use of Photographs

No photographs featuring specific individuals should be replicated or used publicly (web, print) without the prior permission of the individual concerned. Whilst the Congress has devised this policy, the Congress will not be responsible for policing it post-meeting to ensure that the recommendations are adhered to.
